Every year on Palm Sunday, we are invited by our Mission Committee to contribute to the One Great Hour of Sharing offering. Since 1949, the One Great Hour of Sharing offering has drawn Christians together to address the plight of refugees, provide disaster relief, and bring developmental assistance to those in need throughout the world. In cooperation with partner churches in more than 70 countries, your One Great Hour of Sharing contributions support dedicated health care and developmental workers seeking long-term solutions to problems of poverty, hunger and disease. Here at home, funds are made available for disaster relief long after events have faded from the headlines.



One of the organizations that receives the support of our One Great Hour of Sharing Offering is Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, the group that provided shelter and work for our adult mission teams that traveled multiple times to Houma, Louisiana, the group that provided trauma counseling to the residents of Kirkwood after the shooting years ago, and the group who distributes the 120 Clean Up Buckets we make each year to help those in times of natural disasters. While FEMA and the Red Cross provide immediate aid, it tends to be short-term. The people who stay to provide long-term help with recovery are the Presbyterians and other people of faith, and it means the world to those who are in need of assistance. They shed tears of joy and gratitude knowing that they matter, that they are remembered, and that they have not been abandoned. It's good to know that our contributions to the One Great Hour of Sharing touch them and heal them with Christian love and concern. With the help of your gifts, we serve together as ambassadors of Christ in a very tangible way.

You already received a letter from Candace O'Connor, the chair of the Mission Committee, inviting you to support the One Great Hour of Sharing offering on Palm Sunday, April 9. But it's still not too late to give. You can make your gift for weeks to come. By participating in the One Great Hour of Sharing, yours becomes more than a single voice crying in the wilderness. Together, pooling our resources and gifts, we make a significant difference in the world of the homeless, the poor, the hungry and the ill-clothed, that God's works might be revealed around the globe.

**Good Friday, April 14**

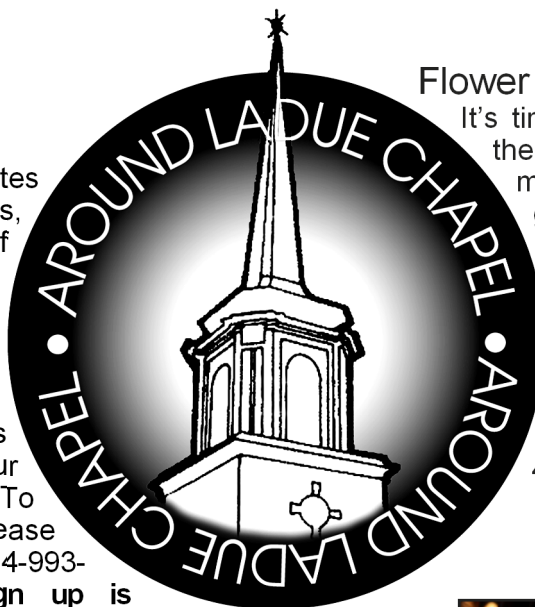
**7:30 a.m. in Fellowship Hall**
